

#### **Tidbits about fair!**

#### **Shooting Sports:**

County Shoot: Arrive at your range 30 minutes early to check in. Bring plenty of water to stay hydrated and snacks if needed for the day. Remember to bring eye and ear protection, as well as your firearms, ammo, and other needed supplies. Awards will be 30 minutes after the last round of each discipline at that discipline's range. Shooting Sports Council will have Garfield County Shooting Sports hats available for purchase at the Air, Archery and .22 Rifle ranges.

General Project Day: Please see tidbits on the next page. Exhibiting a general project and completing an interview is **required for all shooting sports members.** 

#### **Horse & Livestock exhibitors:**

Add-on forms will be available from the office *after* July 4th.

At Fair: Horse and Livestock members will need to pick up their information packet in the Extension Office upon arrival to the fairgrounds. The packet will contain your fair schedule, your back tags (with safety pins) to exhibit, stall card (with zip ties) for each of your pens and/or stalls, and a fair guide. Stall cards are REQUIRED on your pens EVEN IF you have club or personal signs and MUST include emergency contact information.

During fair events, classes can be dropped but not changed or added.

After fair, stalls and pens must be cleaned and checked out by your

Superintendent. For Horse this will be on Sunday, July 16th after the awards ceremony. For Livestock this will be on Sunday, July 30th from 9-11am.

Don't forget: Show clothes, wash rack hoses, shavings, show equipment (halters, pig bats, etc.), grooming equipment, cleaning equipment (shovels, brooms, wheelbarrows, etc.), waterers, feed pans.

#### **General Project exhibitors:**

This year's Fair Parade will take place during general projects judging. The North Entrance will be open for families to use during this time. All judging will pause from 11-Noon to allow youth to participate in the parade.

Please be 15 minutes early to your interview appointments. Bring your completed record book in a binder or folder and your display board (tri-fold 4'x3' that folds flat - no 3D items) or your display item. Check in at the table in the breezeway between North & South Hall when you arrive.

After fair, you need to pick up your project on Sunday, July 30th between 10am and noon. NO EXCEPTIONS
